Gift from Couple Honors Heroes and Helps People with Heart Disease

On November 1, 2016, a surprise gathering was held to reunite a local couple with the physicians and nurses who cared for them at Aspirus Wausau Hospital.

Don and Connie Huehnerfuss experienced wonderful care at Aspirus when Don was in need of emergent heart and vascular care.

Don Huehnerfuss remarked, “I would like to honor several persons of Aspirus. I’m compiling this with the help of my dear wife as I don’t remember many of these ‘happenings’ but will be forever grateful for the actions of a few.

On Monday, November 23, 2015, I was rushed to Aspirus Wausau Hospital after collapsing from leg numbness. Because of a quick thinking emergency room doctor, Dr. Tom Koepke, and a CAT scan, Dr. Jamie Costa was called in. At 1:00 a.m., Dr. Costa immediately set up a surgical room, a surgical team, and told my wife I could very possibly lose my legs or my life. Dr. Costa performed miracles that night. He didn’t finish until after 5:00 a.m. and saved my life and both my legs.

Because of the severity of my illness, I was in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) for almost a full month. Two nurses stand out in my mind who helped continuously with caring and attention that helped me and my wife through this whole ordeal. I am so appreciative of the care and concern from this team. I cannot thank Dr. Costa or the nurses, Holly Trembath and Erin Dennis, and Dr. Koepke enough. I feel I owe them my life.

Additionally, the night I collapsed I had been at my brother-in-law's funeral during the day. He had also been in the same ICU for ten days before this. I really want to thank nurse, Deanne Webster, for standing in and helping me and my wife through the difficult time of making decisions, donating the gift of life, and finally staying with my brother-in-law as he passed on.

All three nurses and Drs. Costa and Koepke have left memorable, pleasant experiences in our lives. We want to thank them with this special gift for the Aspirus Hero program. These five people are my and my wife's heroes."

This generous \$10,000 gift from the Huehnerfuss's will be used to support people who suffer from heart disease and heart failure.

Gift from B.A. & Esther Greenheck Foundation Protects Babies' Lives

On July 19, 2016, a special gathering was held in the Anya Marie Jackson Newborn Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at Aspirus Wausau Hospital, to celebrate a gift of \$27,571 from the B.A. & Esther Greenheck Foundation. This gift helped advance the level of care provided to babies and families at Aspirus by providing the following:

- Advanced Neonatal Simulator Manikin and training for health care professionals who provide specialized care for critically ill newborns.
- High Intensity Bili Blanket Unit to help reduce the amount of bilirubin in the baby's skin to assist the liver in regulating the level of bilirubin in the blood and prevent jaundice, a common condition in babies born prematurely, and potential brain damage from high bilirubin levels.
- Portable Neopuff Infant Resuscitation Units to protect babies during resuscitation to ensure the safety of their lungs and delivery of the appropriate amount of pressure needed to give a baby a breath.

Sarah Walder, APNP, shared that "the advanced neonatal simulator manikin, which we've named Halle, is used to train countless health care professionals, students, and community groups who can help protect babies' lives. The NICU team is grateful for the support of the B.A. & Esther Greenheck Foundation to help make this technology and training possible!"

Aspirus & Community Partners Invest in Future Medical Providers

In 2016, Aspirus announced the creation of a program and community collaboration to address the national physician shortage and meet the needs of people and communities in north central Wisconsin and Upper Michigan today and for future generations.

The Aspirus Scholars Program will provide generous scholarships to medical students and advanced practice provider students – such as physician assistants and nurse practitioners – and connect them to Aspirus and the communities served by Aspirus during their training. In return, students will commit to future employment at Aspirus in the areas of primary care, psychiatry, or general surgery.

Scholarship amounts will vary based on the cost of tuition, and employment commitments will range from three to five years. The inaugural class of Aspirus Scholars included the following medical student and physician assistant students who accepted scholarships in return for five-year employment commitments with Aspirus:

- **Christopher Zeman**, Medical Student – Medical College of Wisconsin-Central Wisconsin Campus. Interests include primary care and general surgery.
- **Kristin Erickson**, Physician Assistant Student – University of Wisconsin-Madison Wisconsin Physician Assistant Community-Based Tract (wisPACT) program. Interests include primary care and general surgery.
- **Hayley Schanen**, Physician Assistant Student – University of Wisconsin-Madison (wisPACT) program. Interests include primary care and general surgery.

“Our inaugural award recipients already have strong ties to north central Wisconsin and are passionate about medicine and caring for patients,” said Kalynn Pempek, executive director, Aspirus Health Foundation and Volunteer Services. “Each will be a tremendous addition to the Aspirus family and the communities we serve.”

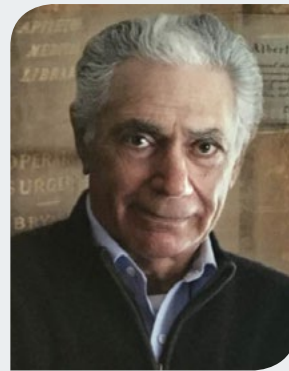
John Slayton founded the Aspirus Health Foundation (formerly the Wausau Health Foundation) as a public charitable organization in 1971 to advance the health of our communities and increase health services for people in north central Wisconsin.

Slayton, (community leader, philanthropist, and former president of Marathon Electric Manufacturing Corporation), guided the work of the Health Foundation from 1971 until 1998. He helped pave the way for the Health Foundation to serve as facilitator of major funding for critical health care projects and services.

He served on the Aspirus Wausau Hospital Board of Directors (formerly Wausau Hospital Center) and several hospital committees in the late '70s and early '80s. During this same timeframe, Betty served as president of the Aspirus Volunteers and on multiple hospital committees. They were both instrumental in ensuring a strong local hospital and excellent regional health care system.

"It is a privilege to continue the work that John and Betty Slayton started in our community 45 years ago," said Kalynn Pempek, executive director of the Aspirus Health Foundation.
